

# Questions for the Car! – Thursday

Today focused on Animal Interactions. Predator and Prey and symbiotic relationships.



**We met Tonka the American Badger.**

He is both a predator and a prey.

**Ask your Camper – What are a badger's predators? How does the badger get away from a predator? How does he hunt his prey? Who does he work together with to hunt sometimes?**

**We looked at different skulls from animals that were Carnivores, Herbivores and Omnivores.**

Each skull has different structures that help the animal eat a certain way or be able to eat different foods. Carnivores have sharp teeth and large jaw bones for muscles to bite down. Herbivores have flatter teeth for grinding vegetation.

**Ask your camper – what were the differences between the Emu feathers and other bird feathers. What are feathers made out of.**

**We dissected Owl Pellets or Casts today.**

**Ask your camper – What did you find in your owl pellet? Why do owls make these pellets? Are animals Carnivores or Herbivores?**
